ABOUT SURF LIFE SAVING NZ

As Aotearoa's leading beach and coastal safety, drowning prevention, and rescue authority, we are unique. We deliver proactive lifeguarding and essential emergency rescue services, a range of public education, beach safety programs, member education, training, and development, and we are also a highly respected sport. With New Zealand having one of the highest rates of drowning (per capita) in the OECD, we are committed to changing this with a vision that 'No one drowns at the beach in Aotearoa, New Zealand.'

We do all this as a charity and rely on the generosity of the public, commercial partners, foundations, and trusts for donations and financial contributions to lead and support our incredible front-line volunteer lifeguarding services. POSITION PURPOSE

This will be achieved through the planning and preparation of event logistics, involving communication and administration tasks alongside the coordination, maintenance, transportation and pack in and out of event related equipment. Any other duties from time to time as determined by the Eastern Region Sport Manager.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Event Planning	 Support the preparation, communication, and planning of logistical requirements for club, local, and regional Lifesaving Sport events.
Event Compliance	 Assist with ensuring all relevant SLSNZ Lifesaving Sport operational policies (NSOP's) and procedures particularly Health and Safety are clearly communicated and implemented.
Event Delivery	 Provide support to the Regional Sport Manager in the successful delivery of Eastern Region Lifesaving Sport events.
Equipment & Logistics Management	 Coordinate and manage the resources required for event delivery, including the logistics of equipment and infrastructure. Ensure the safe and efficient transportation, pack-in, set-up, and pack-out of all event infrastructure and assets.
Volunteer support	 Work alongside and coordinate volunteer work parties as required to support event setup, delivery, and pack-down.
Event Communications	 Support clear, consistent, and timely communication with all stakeholders including athletes, officials, volunteers, and clubs before, during, and after events.
